Dear President Rajoy,

We, the undersigned Spanish and European organisations, are writing to you to ask that Spain takes a more active and engaged role in the implementation process of the Financial Transactions Tax (FTT) within the framework of Enhanced Cooperation agreed by 11 European countries.

Consistent with the position of the Governments of Germany and Austria, civil society organisations believe that only a broad-based tax, covering stocks, bonds, derivatives and (extremely speculative) high-frequency transactions would reduce the volume of financial speculation.

Particularly problematic would be to exempt derivatives from taxation or to tax only some of them. Derivatives represent the biggest share of transactions on the financial markets. Hence, exemptions would lead immediately to a substantial reduction of tax revenues. Furthermore, many derivatives would be misused as instruments to avoid the taxation of shares and bonds. All derivatives whether they serve speculative, or non-speculative purposes, need to be taxed.

Furthermore, regarding the important issue of highly indebted countries taxing sovereign bonds, recent technical analysis has demonstrated that the FTT would not have a negative impact but would, in fact, be positive.

We ask therefore that Spain clearly promote application of the tax on all financial products, such as stocks, derivatives and bonds, which have been identified as taxable in the European Commission's proposal endorsed by the European Parliament. We further strongly urge the Spanish government not to yield to pressures from the financial lobby.

As you are aware, the FTT will not only reduce financial speculation, but constitutes a new source of additional resources - €34 billion per year, of which €5 billion would be collected in

Spain alone, according to data from the European Commission. These revenues are critical to reduce the impact of the financial crisis, fund global public goods such as health and education, and fulfil international commitments. We therefore ask you to send a political signal regarding the use of resources resulting from the FTT, pledging to allocate potential revenues to the fight against poverty in Spain and in impoverished countries, as well as to finance international commitments on climate change.
